Flutist Lindsay Bryden earned her MA under William Bennett at the Royal Academy of Music supported by Canada Council for the Arts and the Sylva Gelber Foundation. She is a graduate and Rising Star of the Royal College of Music and of Interlochen Arts Academy. She has served as principal of Orchestre de la francophonie and Youth Orchestra of the Americas, and is a frequent collaborator in chamber music. As a soloist, she has performed at St Martin in the Fields, the Royal Albert Hall and the NAC, and in such festivals as Music and Beyond, Spitalfields and Vianden.

Lindsay enjoys all aspects of music. Beyond performing, she is a published composer, is active in a variety of chamber music projects which involve writing and arranging, and also has a small teaching studio.
